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BIOGRAPHY

Thomas Adam is a Scottish artist and recent Royal College of Art graduate cur- rently practicing in London. The artist uses a diverse range of print and sculptural methods to produce notions of an extended metaphysical space beyond the surface of the flat image. A recurring male character in the artist's work can be interpreted as an autobiographical figure, contemplative about the self and his surrounding contemporary society, yet disconnected from it. Thomas Adam has synthesised multiple visual influences including the illustrated works of Saul Steinberg and Charles Altamont Doyle, as well as finding inspiration in the obscure stories and hu-morous fallacies of the supernatural and UFO culture.
